# DEED RESTRICTION REMINDERS!

SECTION 8 WASTE MATERIALS - STORAGE

#### Waste Containers

All waste shall be kept in sanitary, covered, animal proof containers. These containers shall be located in an appropriate place, concealed from street view.

Waste Pick-Up

Waste Containers shall be placed at the foot of the driveway no sooner than the evening before the scheduled pick up. These containers must be returned to their storage places by nightfall of the day of pick up.

Storage Time

No waste shall be stored in excess of seven (7) days. Please place waste containers from street view.






### COMMUNITY FALL FESTIVAL

Annual Back-to-School Sales Tax Holiday:

#### August 1, 2025, Through August 31, 2025

Florida's 2025 Back-to-School Sales Tax Holiday begins on Friday, August 1, 2025, and ends on Sunday, August 31, 2025. The holiday now occurs annually, every August.

During the annual sales tax holiday period, tax is not due on the retail sale of:

- Clothing, footwear, wallets, bags, handbags, backpacks, fanny packs, and diaper bags with a sales price of \$100 or less per item
- Certain school supplies with a sales price of \$50 or less per item
- Learning aids and jigsaw puzzles with a sales price of \$30 or less



## CRIME WATCH

REPORT by Nancy Jones, Crime Watch Volunteer

Postal mail vandalism: at our last Crime Watch monthly meeting, (7/3/25), Deputy Jason reviewed the best procedure to report mail vandalism. Contact the Sheriff's Department, 352-754-6830, to have a deputy go to your home address and take a report. Note the deputy's name. Ask for a follow-up to the findings. If you feel that nothing has been done, call again and ask to speak to the Patrol Supervisor.

The Sheriff's Department makes the proper contact with the Postal Service, first locally, then beyond to the Post Master General. You can also make another report at USPS 1-800 275-8777 or online. There may be other situations in nearby communities that we are unaware of and the Sheriff's Department is keeping record. By your reporting, it helps establish a pattern.

In the meantime, we should be in preventive mode. Suggestions: put your address label inside your mail box section. If your key is left in your mailbox, a kind neighbor would know where to return it. Please close any mailboxes you find open. Register for "informed delivery," a free service at USPS.com informed delivery. You will get email images of your mail to be delivered every mail day. In this way, you will know if something was not delivered. This would help narrow down the point of the missing item.

Unfortunately, there are tools, counterfeit keys and methods to gain access to incoming and outgoing mail. This includes the blue mailbox stations. If in doubt, mail inside the post office.

**Litter:** gratitude to the HOA for placing a garbage can, secured to the fishing line recycle bin, in the park. This addition by the dock has significantly cut down on litter. Please encourage your family and friends to keep our beautiful park clean.

Countywide: Deputy Jason stated that the thefts on private property are due to easy access. In other words, unlocked cars, open garage doors, unlocked doors. Construction sites have had items easily stolen because these, also, are not secured.

Crime Watch and Deputy Jason have plans to include an educational component to each monthly meeting. All are encouraged to attend. Nonmembers are welcomed. Look for announcement on River Country Facebook Forum/Living. Our meetings are the first Thursday of every month.
