The other caveat is a VARI-ENCE, whereby the owner is asking us to consider bypassing the current guideline due to a special circumstance. Acceptable reasons maybe based on hardship or mitigating circumstances. Variances are not approved just because the homeowner wants to do something that is outside of the community guidelines.

In closing, River country belongs to us all. Let's continue to work together to make this a better place to live.



# LABOR DAY

#### The Labor Day Hurricane of 1935

Labor Day arrives during the peak of hurricane season, and there have been a number of memorable storms on or around Labor Day weekend, including 2005's Hurricane Katrina and Hurricane David in 1979.

Among the most destructive was the unnamed hurricane of 1935 which hit the Florida Keys as the first-recorded Category 5 storm in U.S. history, leaving near total destruction in its wake. With winds of 185 mph and an estimated storm surge of 18 feet, the Labor Day hurricane claimed nearly 500 lives. It goes down as one of the worst hurricanes to ever make landfall in the contiguous United States.

- Labor Day was declared a national holiday by President Grover Cleveland in 1894.
- President Lyndon B. Johnson declared the holiday would always be celebrated on a Monday.
- Labor Day is celebrated on the 1st Monday in September.
- The actual founder of Labor Day is unknown even today.
- New Jersey is home to the American Labor Museum.
- Other countries celebrate a form of Labor Day, known by different names, such as May Day, Labour Day, and International Workers' Day.
- There is still a Labor Day Parade in New York City.
- Labor Day occurs at the peak of hurricane season.
- Several major storms have occurred on or around Labor Day weekend, including Hurricane Katrina, Hurricane David, & the unnamed hurricane of 1935 that hit the Florida Keys on Labor Day as a Category five hurricane.



#### Solicitors' vs Lead Person

Many reported a young man on a hoverboard going throughout our community, as well as other communities, asking if the resident was interested in pest control services. He was considered a lead person rather than a solicitor. This basically meant that he was not selling, only wanted to know if the resident was interested. If yes, than the solicitor who has a permit, would do the follow-up. The company found a loophole in the county ordinance.

Per the Sheriff's Department: if you want to keep a solicitor or lead from your property, post a "no trespassing sign" at your door. Then, if they do go onto your property, the deputy can give them a warning and escort them out of our community. Personally, as I was at my neighbor across from my house, I witnessed this same young man, turn into my driveway, saw the sign and backed out.

# WATER RESTRICTIONS

Water Restrictions per Hernando County Ordinance. "In Hernando County the first offense of a water violations will receive a citation that carries a \$100 fine. The second offense will receive a citation that carries a \$500 fine. (Thereafter, each violation goes up significantly.)

The ordinance applies to all sources of water, public supplied, and from wells, rivers, lakes or other bodies of water. Hernando County's current one day a week watering schedule has been in place since July of 2010.

If you are having your lawn replaced or partially replaced call the Hernando County Utilities Department beforehand: (352) 754-4037 for a water allowance and they will inform you of the particular allowance for your lawn.

\*One day per week watering restrictions apply to all sources of water in Hernando County. This includes all private wells, rivers, lakes, and streams.


